We are excited to announce new transfer plan opportunities for SPC students! In partnership with New College of Florida, 5 new transfer plans are being developed.

Two, Biology and Marine Biology, are already active for Spring 2023 (615). Three more, Psychology, Chemistry, and Economics, will be developed later this semester.

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## NEW Ed. Studies BS Subplan



The College of Education is adding a 4th subplan option to the Educational Studies BS degree - Training and Development. This subplan will prepare students to create, administer, and deliver training programs for local business and community organizations.

SPC's College of Education was awarded funds from the Florida Future Critical Workforce Needs Grant (FCWN) to develop a new Training and Development subplan within the Educational Studies and Leadership BS program. This new subplan was developed in partnership with local community stakeholders and potential employers who are seeking graduates skilled in creating, administering, and delivering training programs. These skills are applicable across varied vocational fields and are currently in high demand by local businesses and community organizations in the Tampa Bay region.

The new track will be marketed to current AA students as well as surrounding companies and organizations within Pinellas, Hillsborough, and Pasco counties. There are a variety of large companies whose employees may have degrees outside of education (i.e. business, psychology, etc.) but may want

their employees to earn degrees or certificates in Training & Development. This subplan targets the adult learner, both as the recipient of the curriculum as well as the ultimate end-user. In addition, because this degree track is offered 100% online, we anticipate enrollment from across the state of Florida.

not be a teach-out since these are not degrees from which students could graduate.

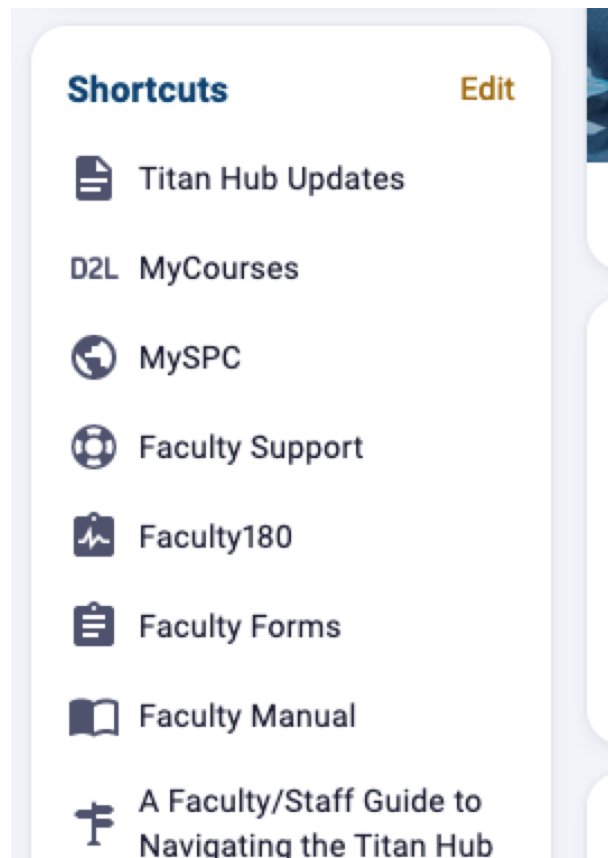
