Dial 911 for immediate emergency assistance from police, fire and medical on all campuses. Then alert Security Dispatch at 727-791-2560.

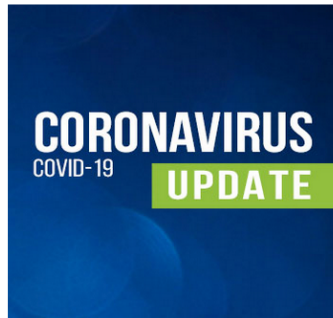

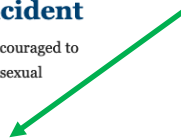

## EMERGENCY ALERTS

- [COVID-19 Update Aug. 22, 2022](#)  
Face coverings at St. Petersburg College are now optional. Individuals may choose to wear them at any time based on their own preference and informed by their personal level of risk.
- [Hurricane Season \(June 1 – Nov. 30\)](#)  
Hurricane season runs from June 1 through Nov. 30. During this time, SPC officials closely monitor Pinellas County Emergency Management bulletins and official weather forecasts when SPC falls within the National Hurricane Center’s zone of landfall probability. By doing so, SPC will have time to activate the college’s Emergency Management Plan, alert campus personnel, recommend protective actions, including evacuations, and communicate emergency notifications.
