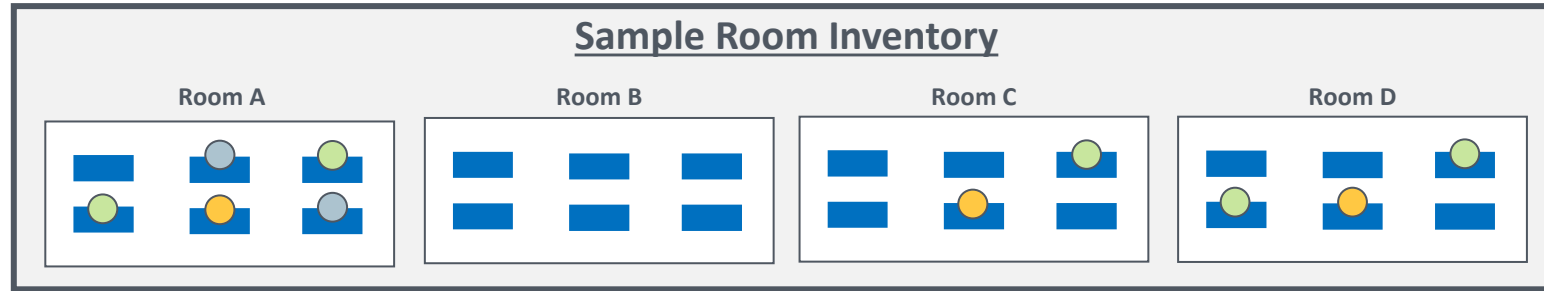

Room Utilization

The percentage of scheduled rooms that are scheduled Monday-Friday, 9:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m.

3 out of 4 scheduled rooms are occupied.
There is a **Room Utilization** of 75%.

Room Capacity

The number of chairs that a teaching space is configured to hold based on the registrar's space inventory.

Room D has a **Room Capacity** of 6.

Position Utilization

The percentage of available seats that are occupied within each utilized room.

Room D has 3 of 6 seats occupied.
There is a **Position Utilization** of 50%.

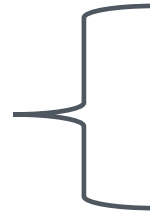

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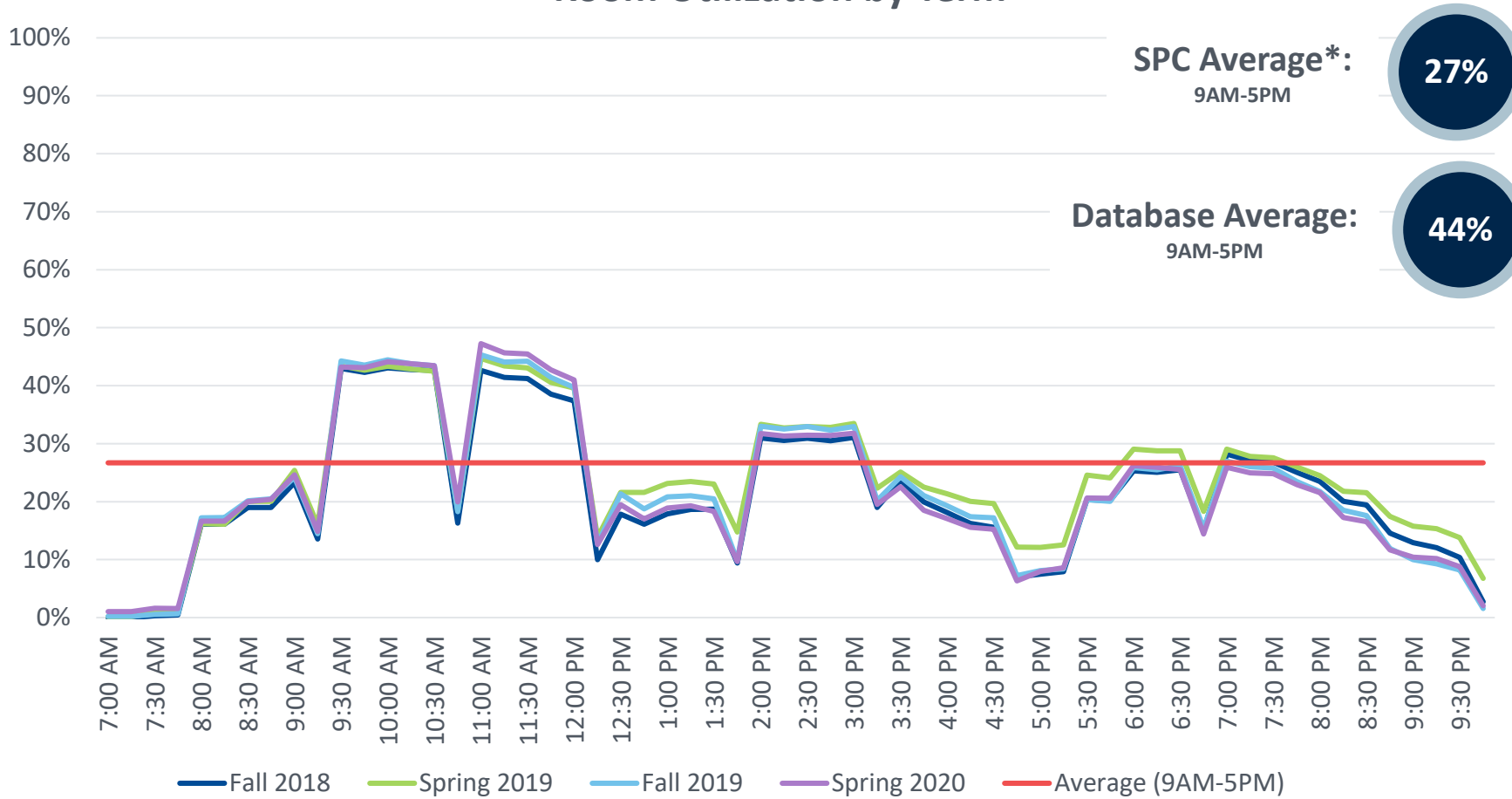

Room Utilization by Term: Fall 2018 – Spring 2020

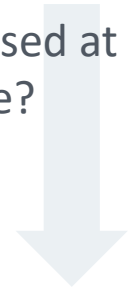

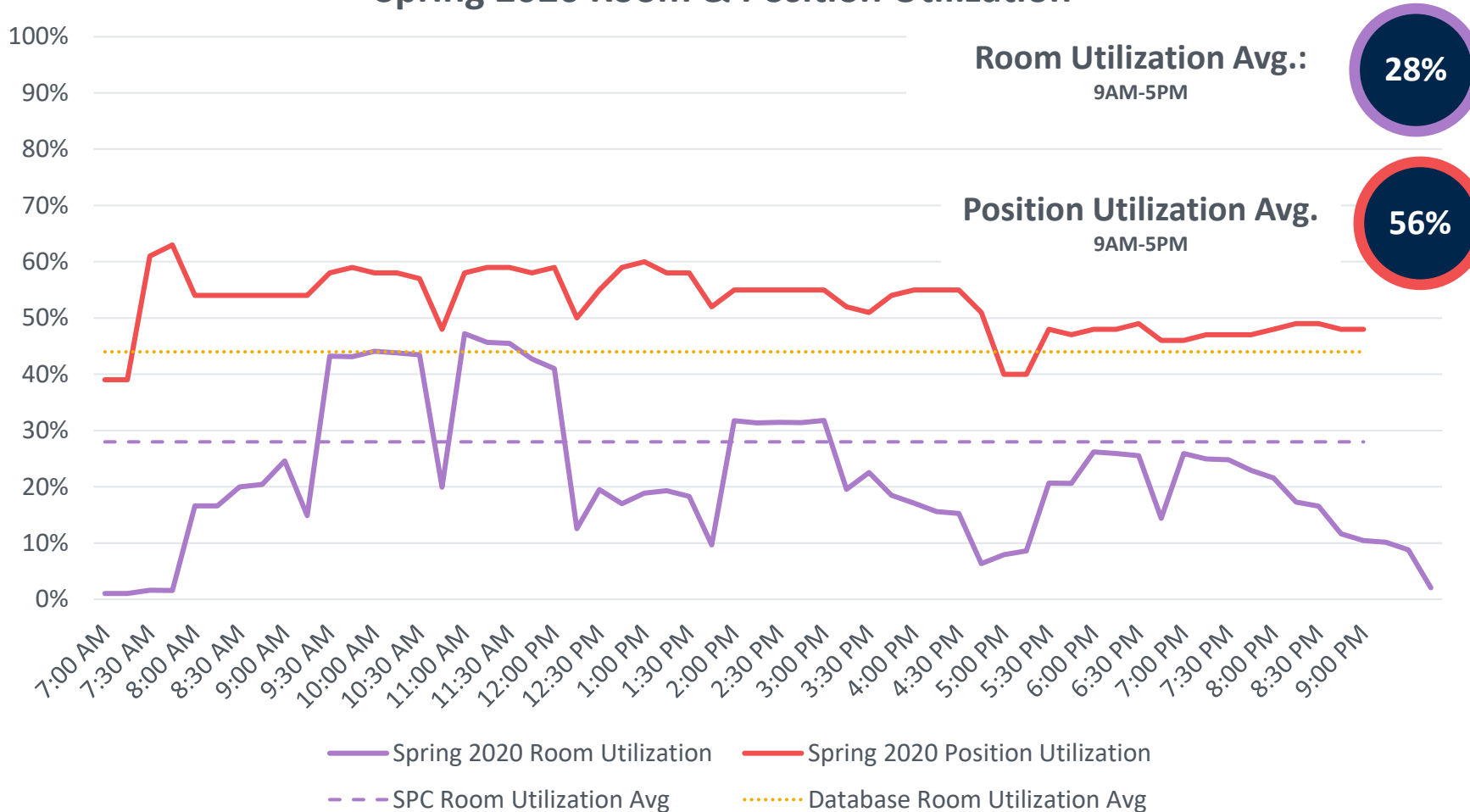

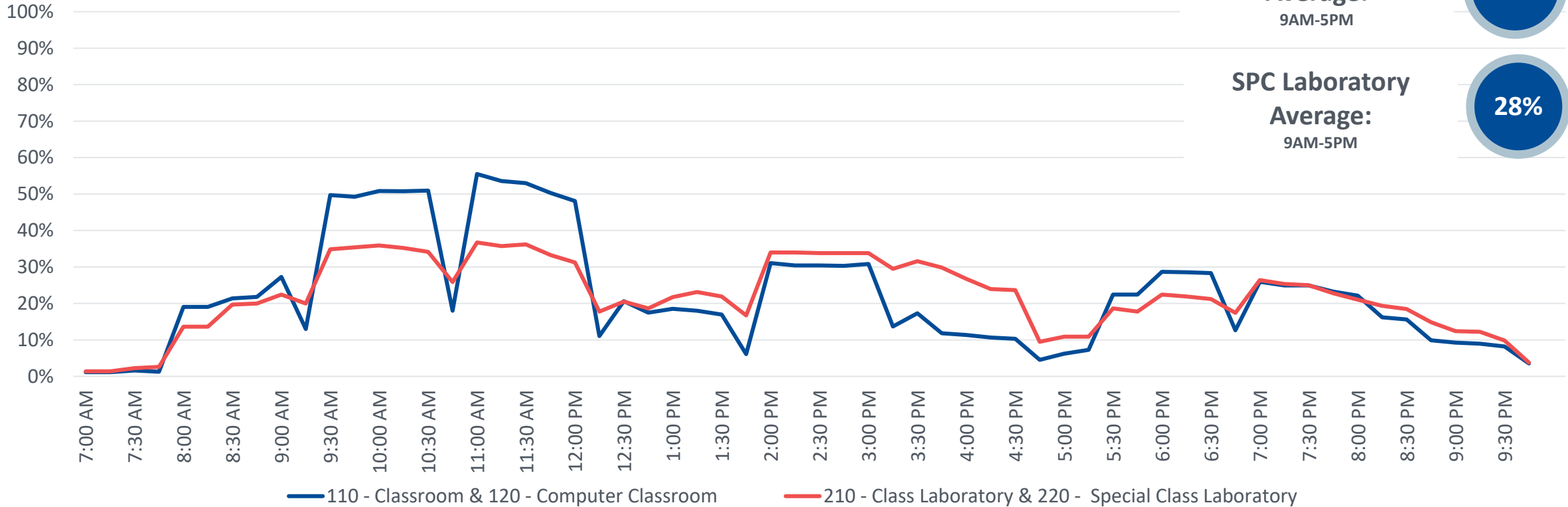

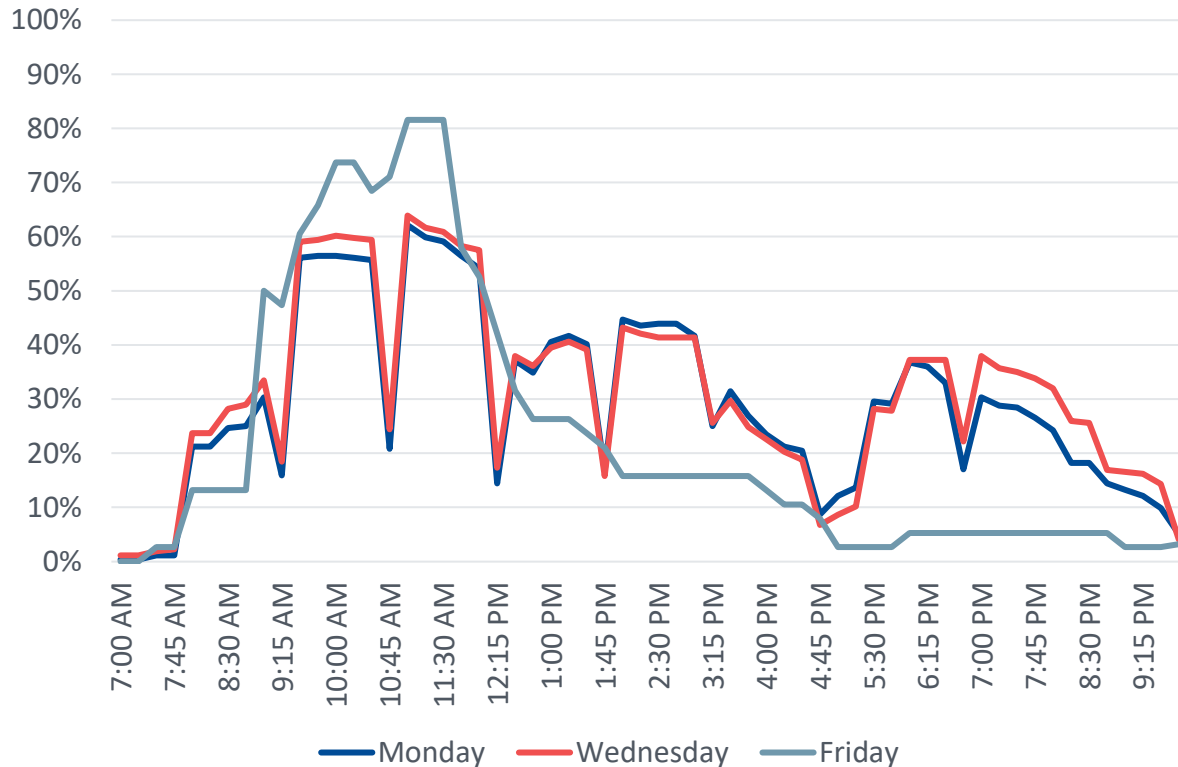

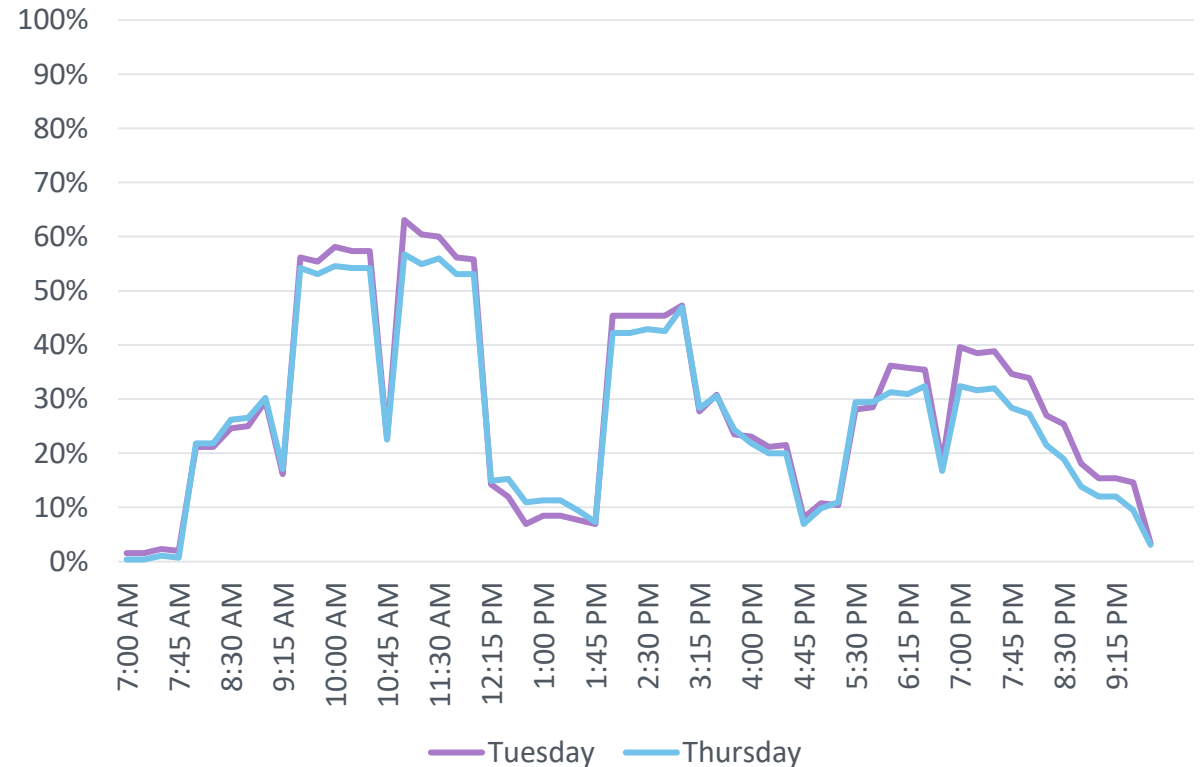
Room Utilization by Weekday: Monday-Friday

Room Utilization: Tuesday, Thursday

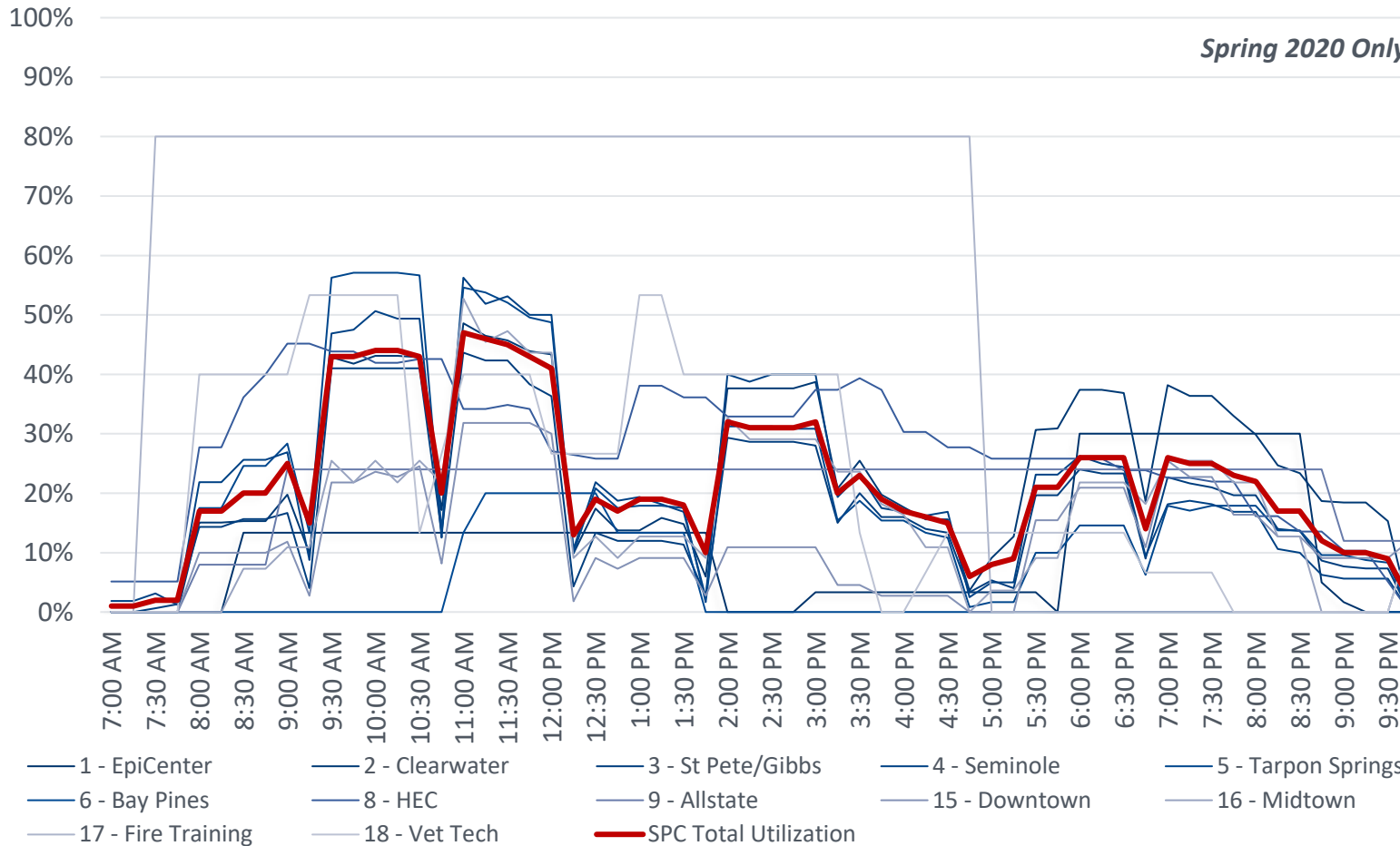

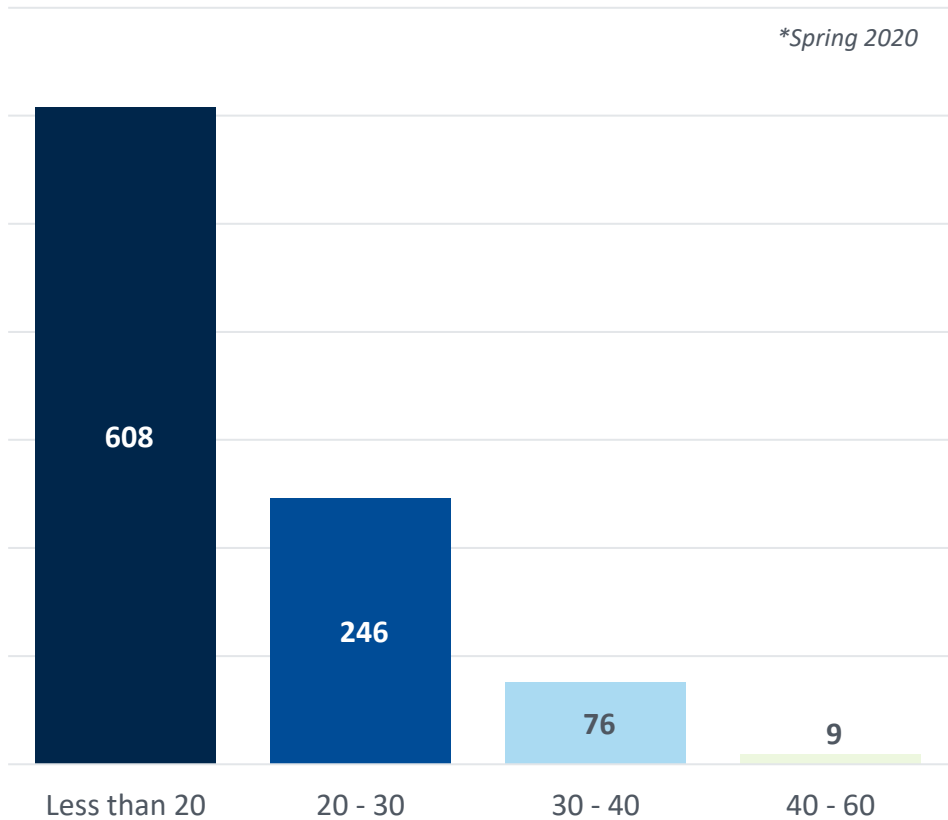

Understanding the Gap Between Course Enrollment and Room Capacity

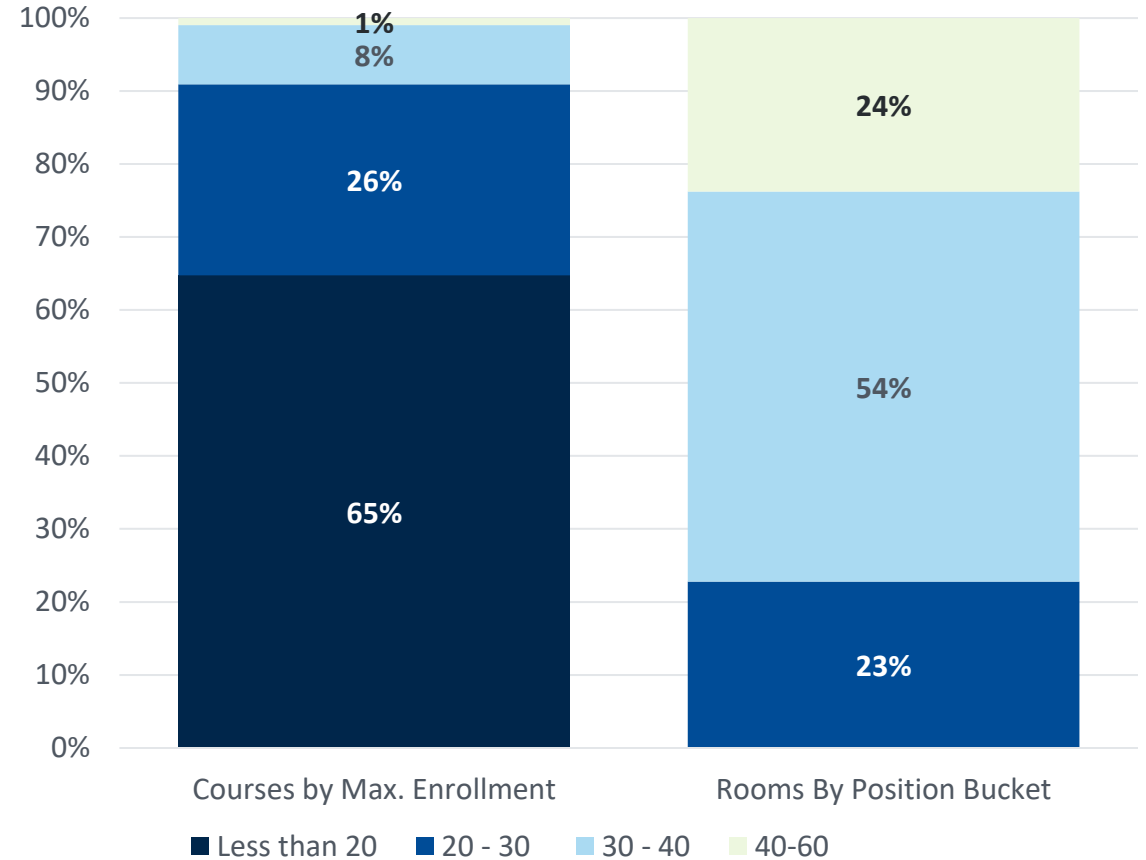
Although 68% of courses have an enrollment Less than 20, 78% of rooms have a capacity of over 30 positions

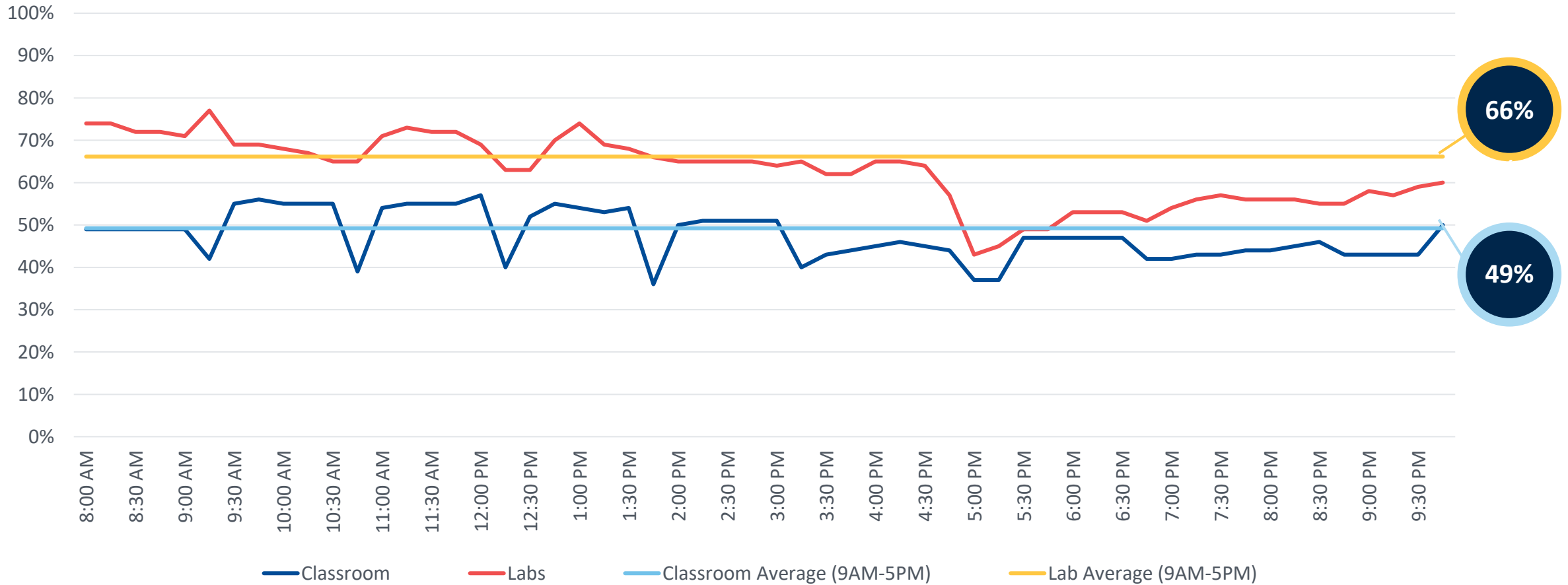
Distribution of Course Size vs Room Size

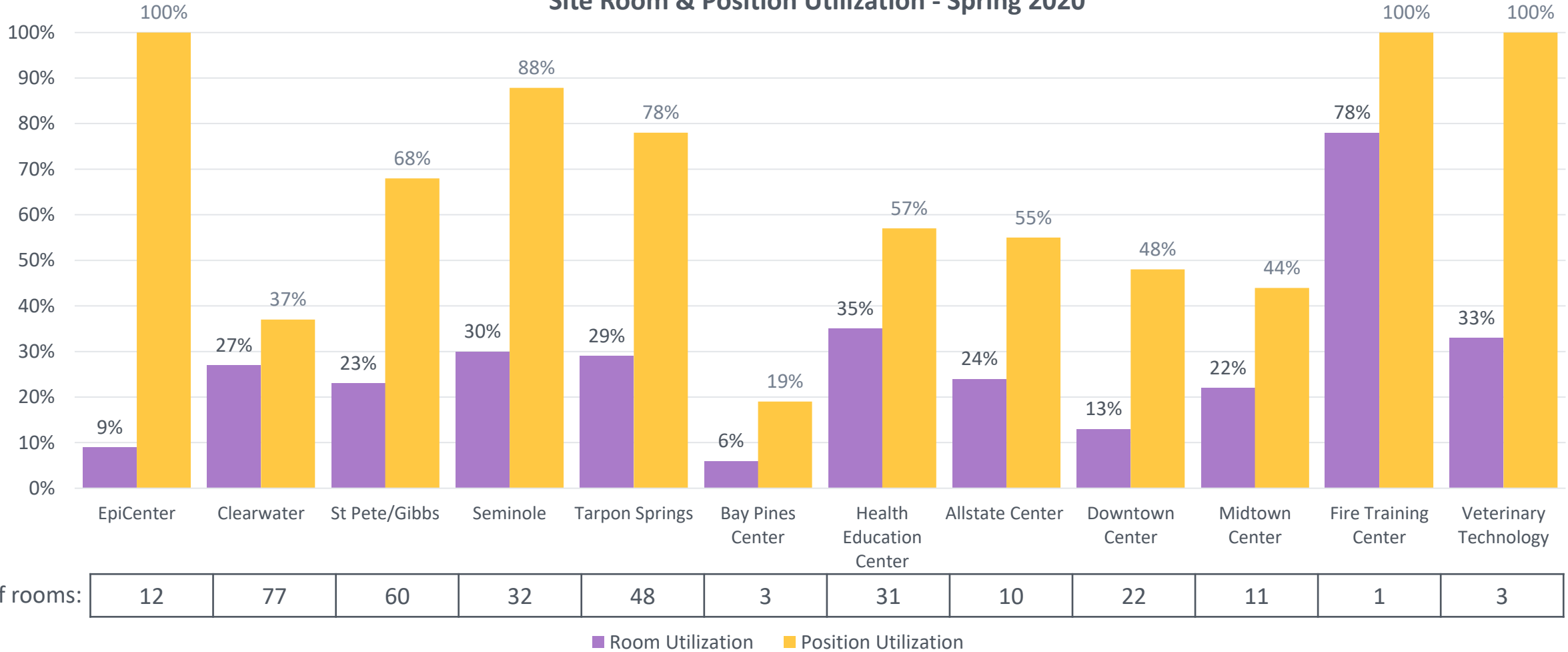
Position utilization is higher in Laboratories than Classrooms

Position Utilization: Classrooms vs Labs

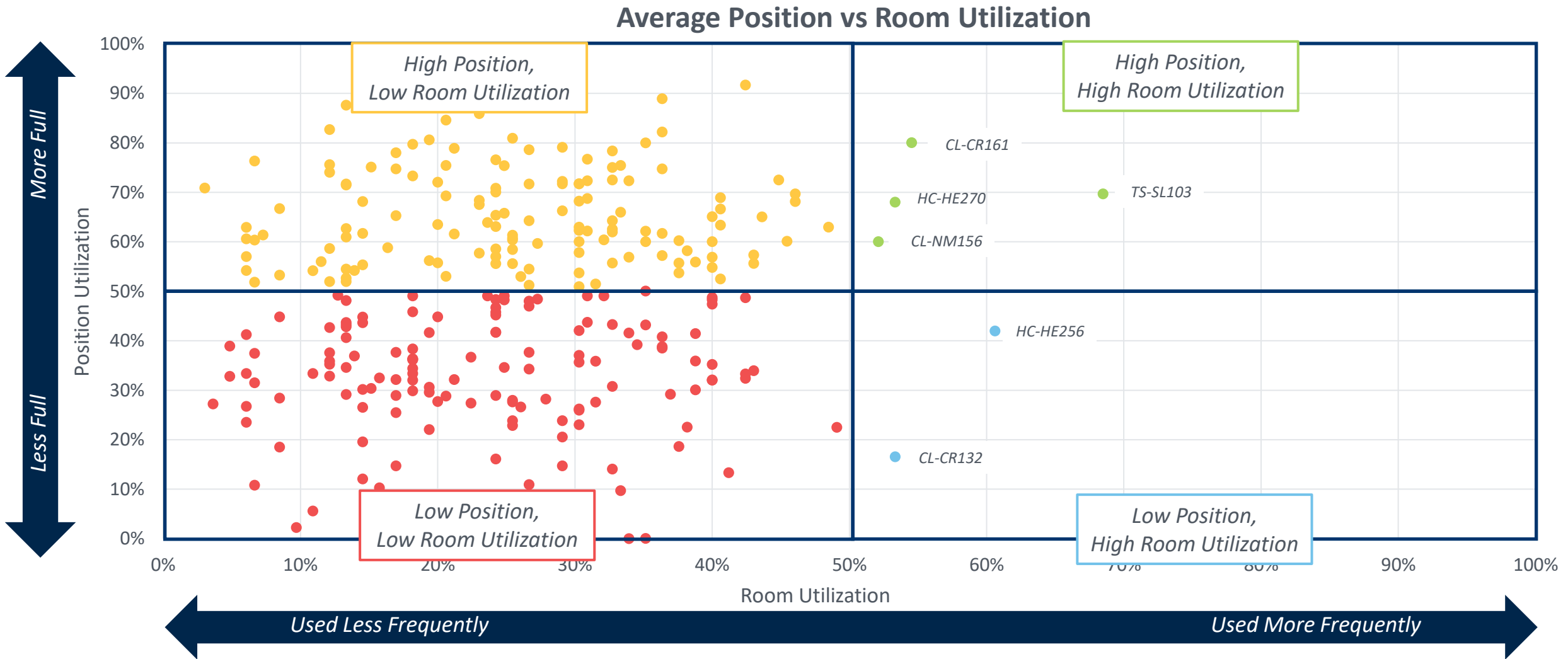

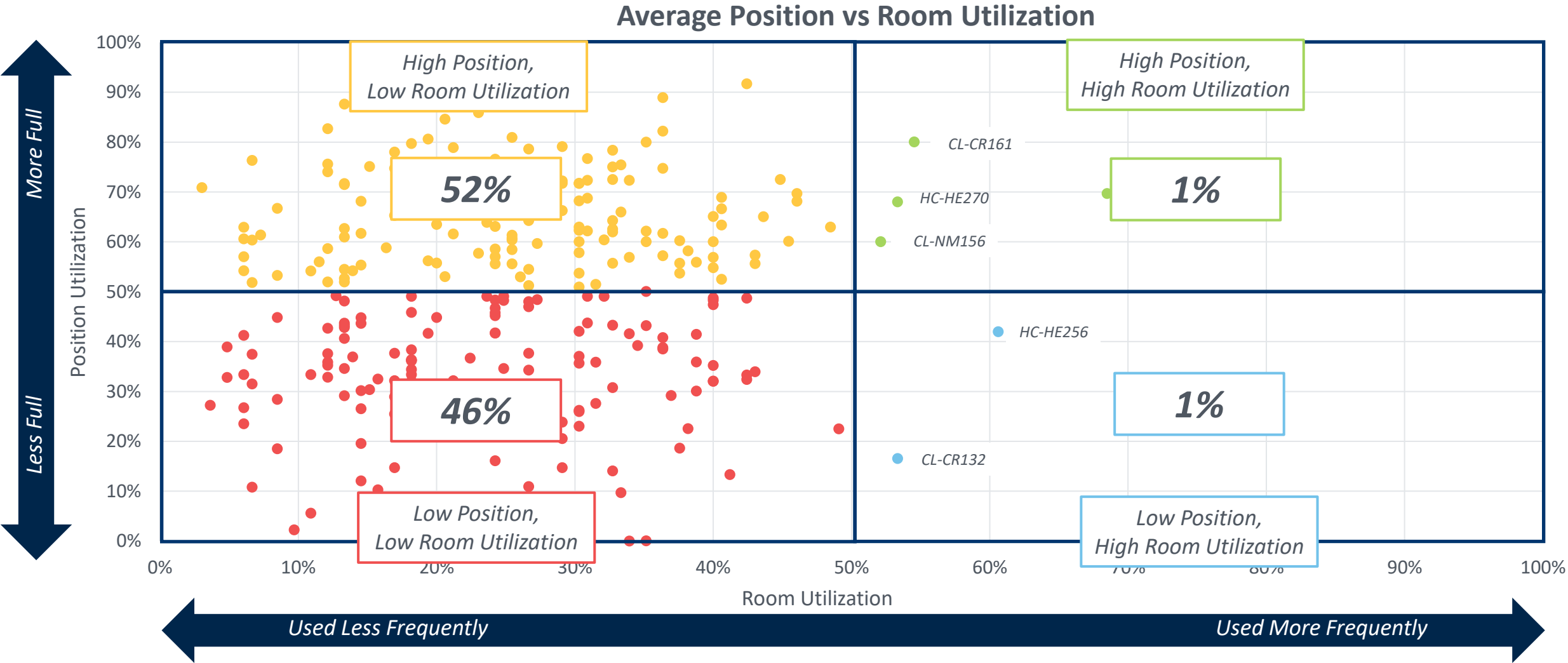
Site Room & Position Utilization - Spring 2020

Opportunity	Summary of Findings	Proposed Changes
<i>Centralize Scheduling Process & Data</i>	Overall room utilization is low, and there is room for increased utilization in even the best utilized spaces	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Increase centralization of scheduling process• Reassign the responsibility of room scheduling to site provost or scheduler• Explore options in new/upgraded software to consolidate scheduling & event data into one area
<i>Align class schedules & times to meet student demand</i>	In discussions with each site, feedback was frequently given that existing schedules and course times were determined for departmental preference	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use existing scheduling data and engage with existing students to determine the most in-demand courses and the best time & location to offer them
<i>Embrace the existing campus flexibility</i>	With low room utilization across each site and many larger rooms and smaller classes, use the current opportunity to explore consolidating/rearranging the existing sites to maximize the existing real estate.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Small renovations to existing space can break up larger rooms into more smaller rooms which can help with flexibility when moving departments• Be sure to align future class sizes with the size of classrooms to maximize position utilization• Create a standard “menu” for technology to help understand the needs of teachers and where they best align with campus space

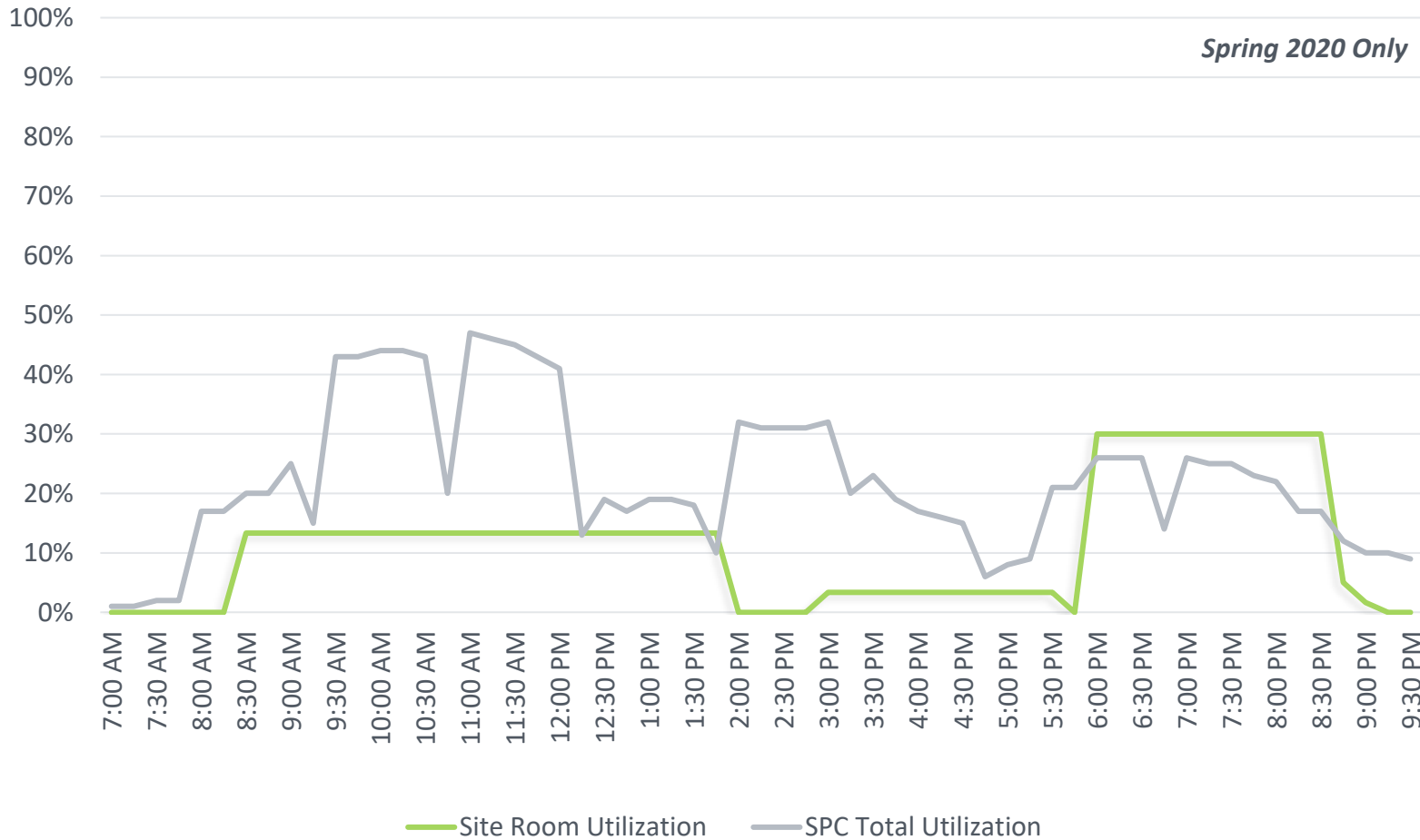

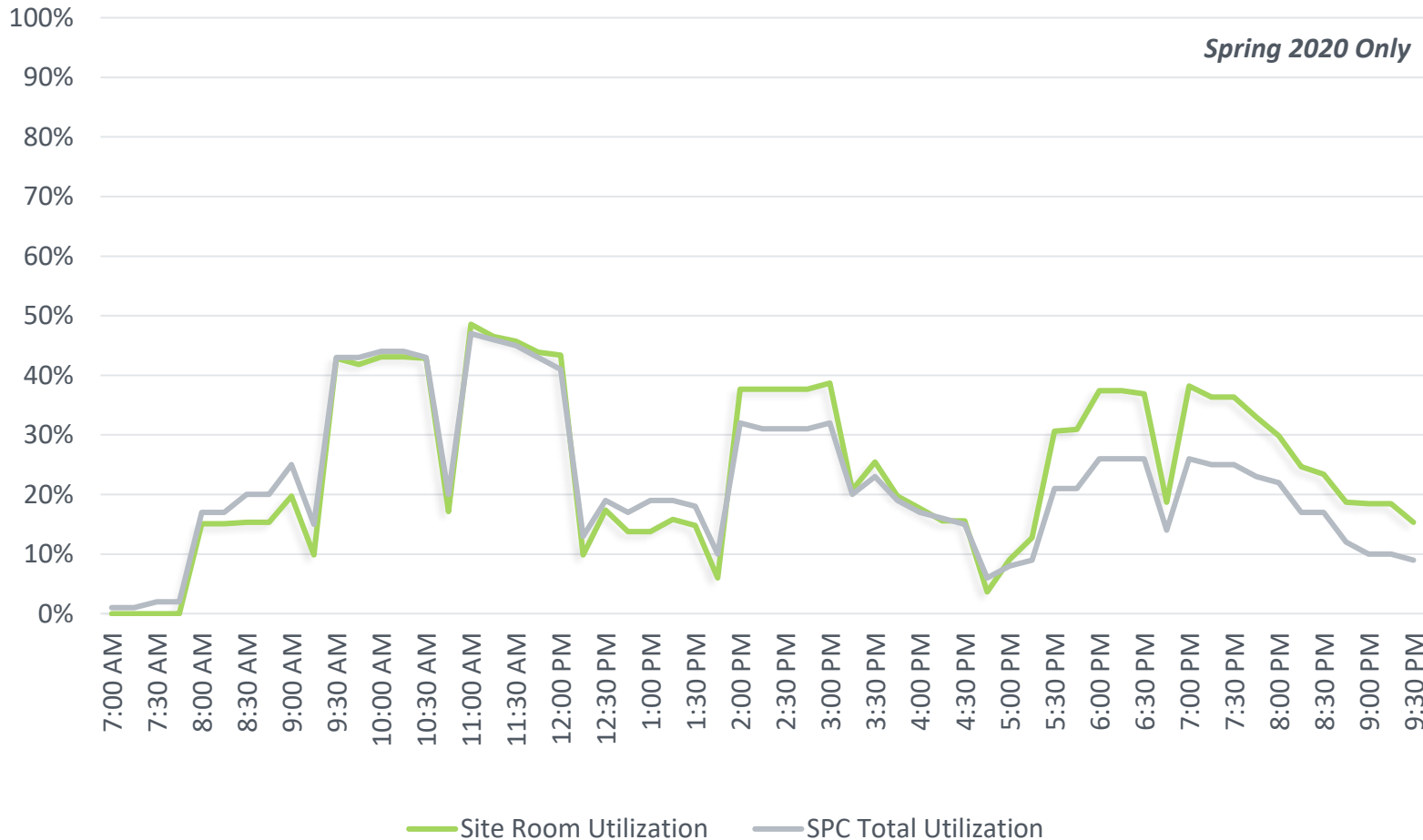

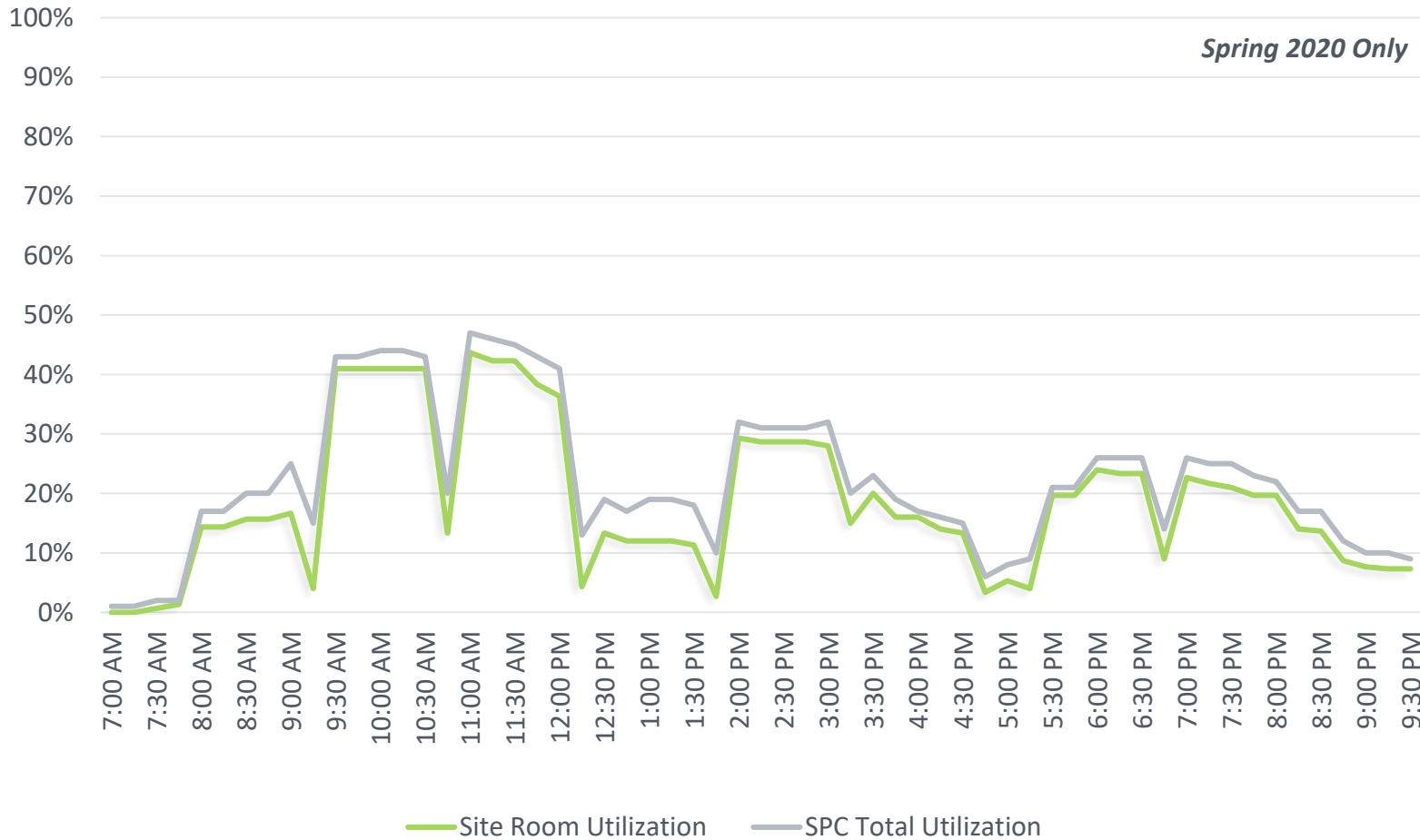

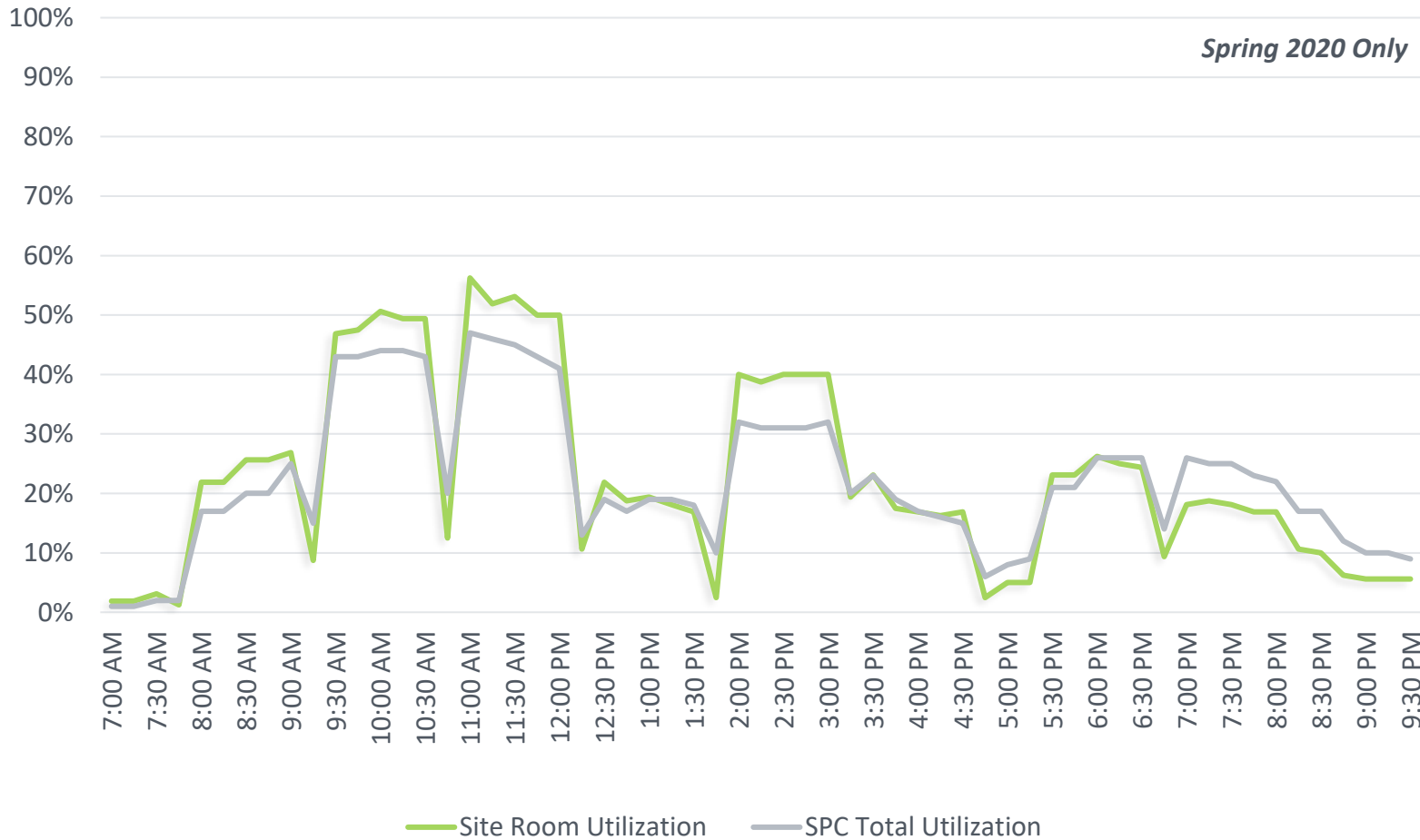

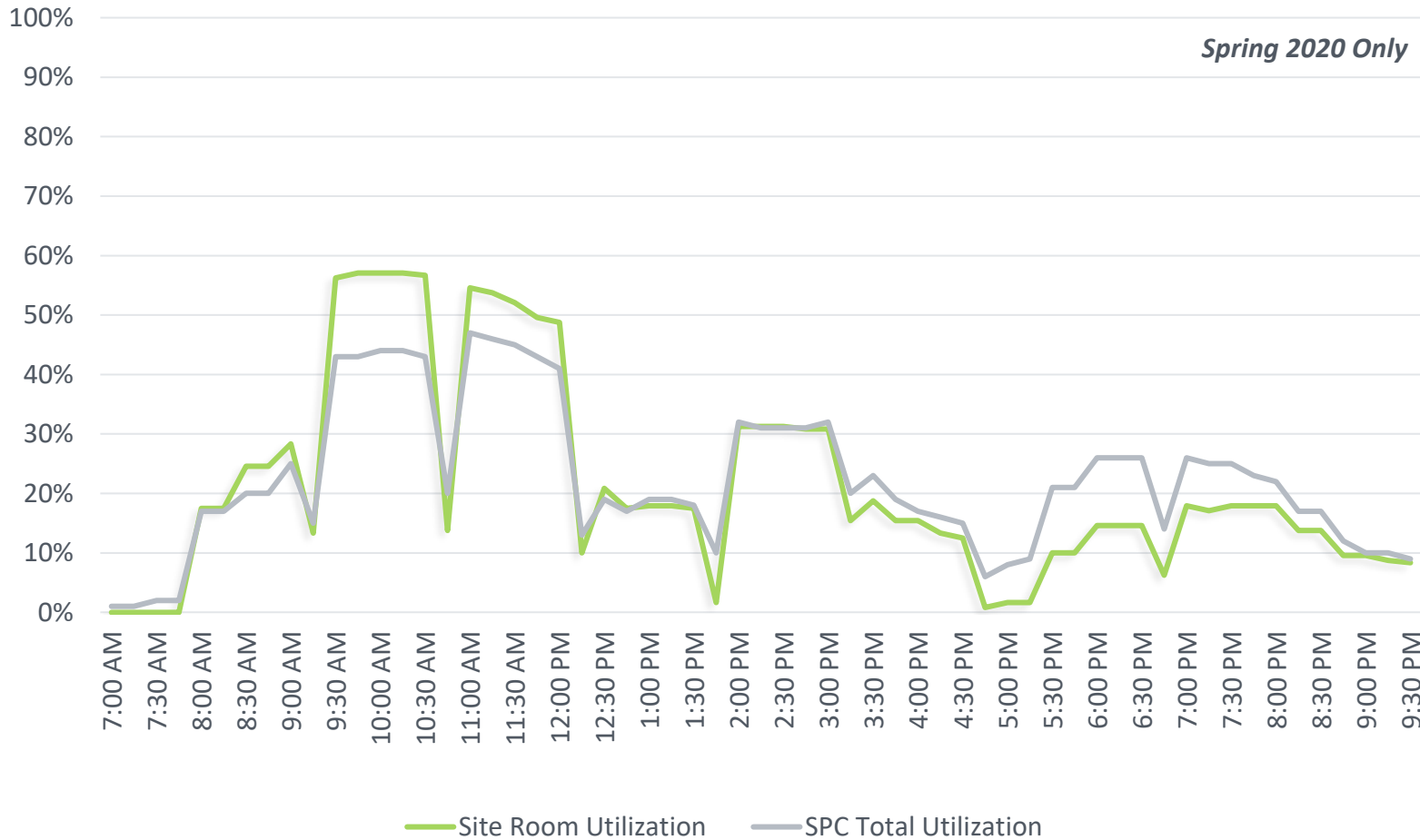

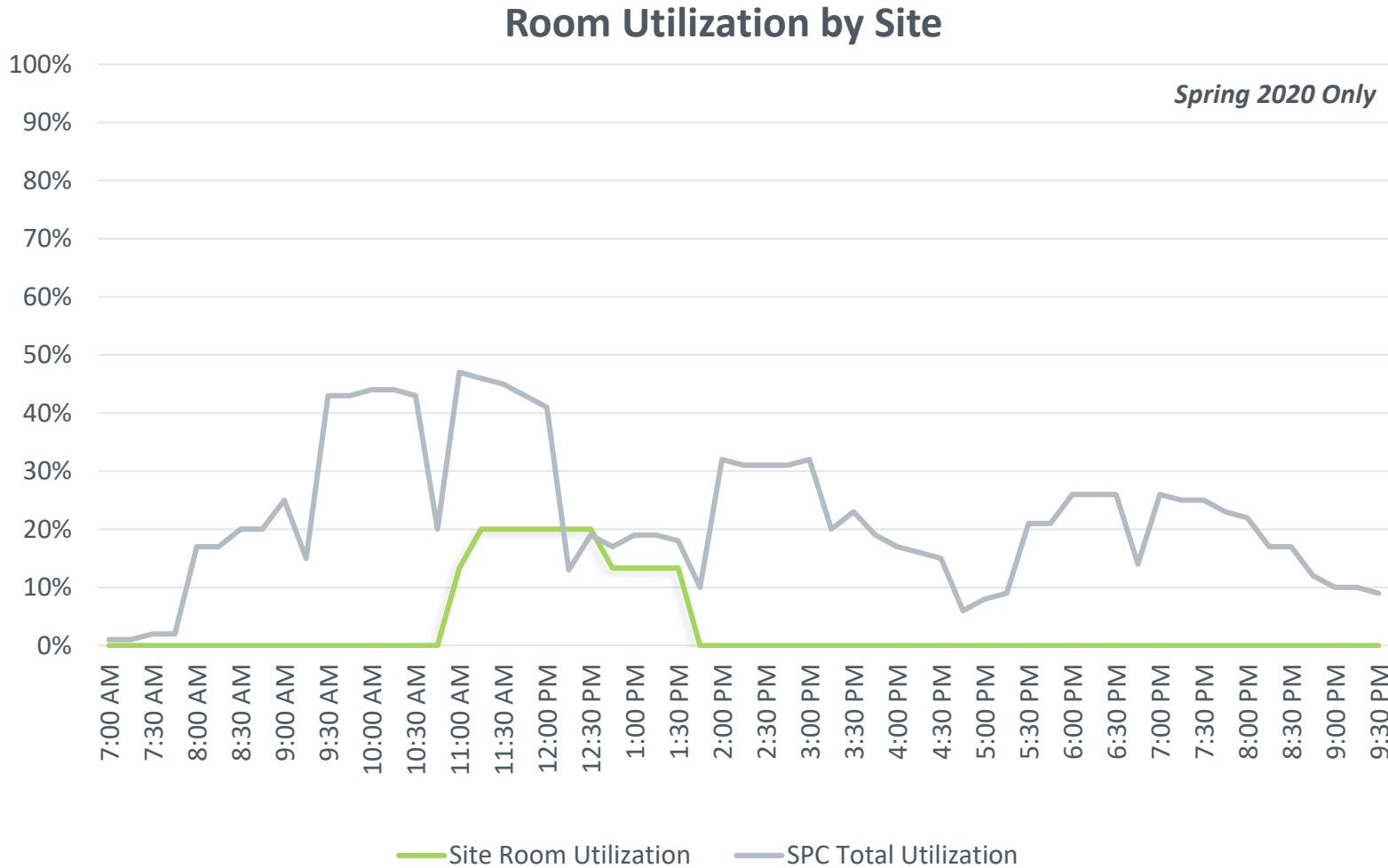

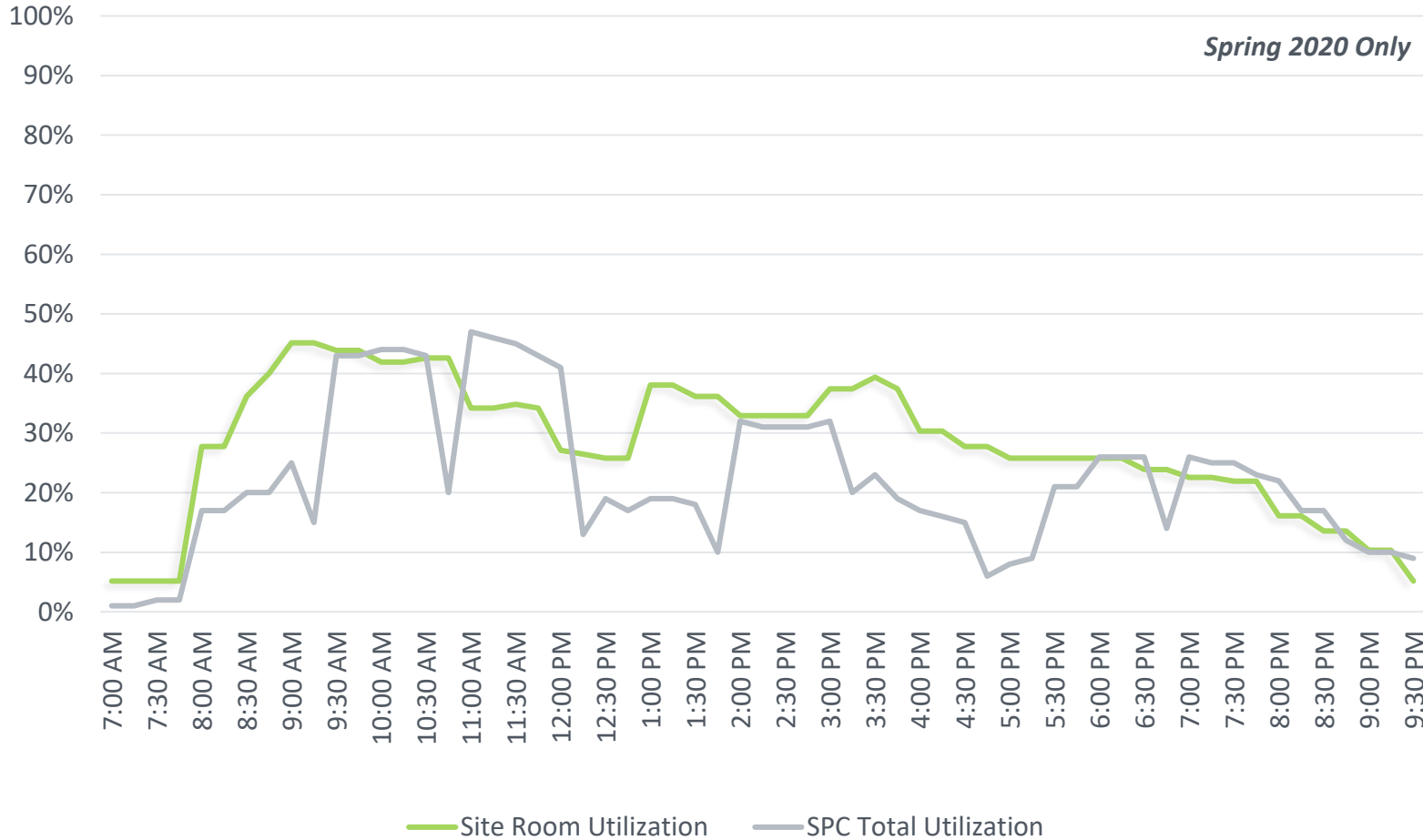

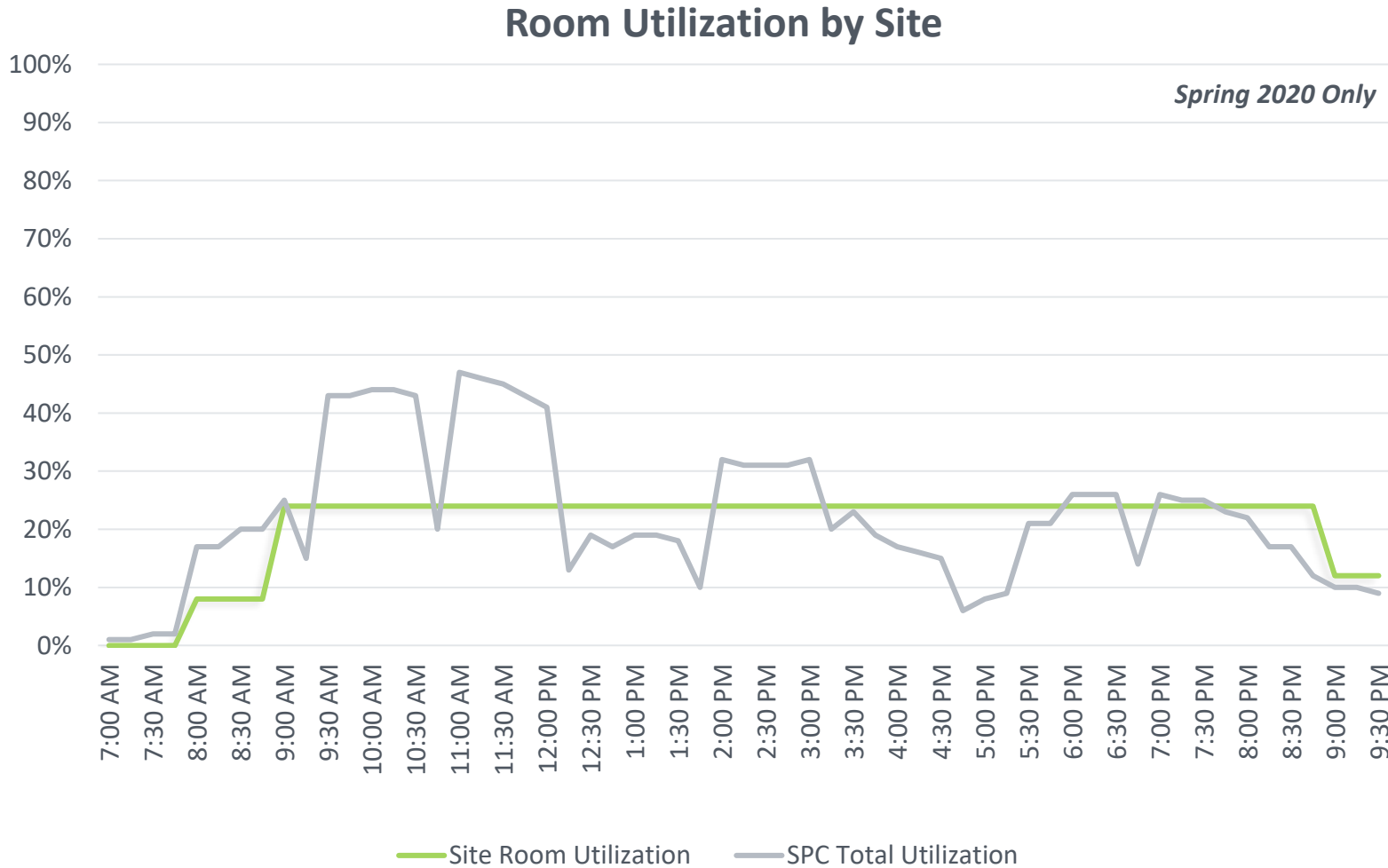

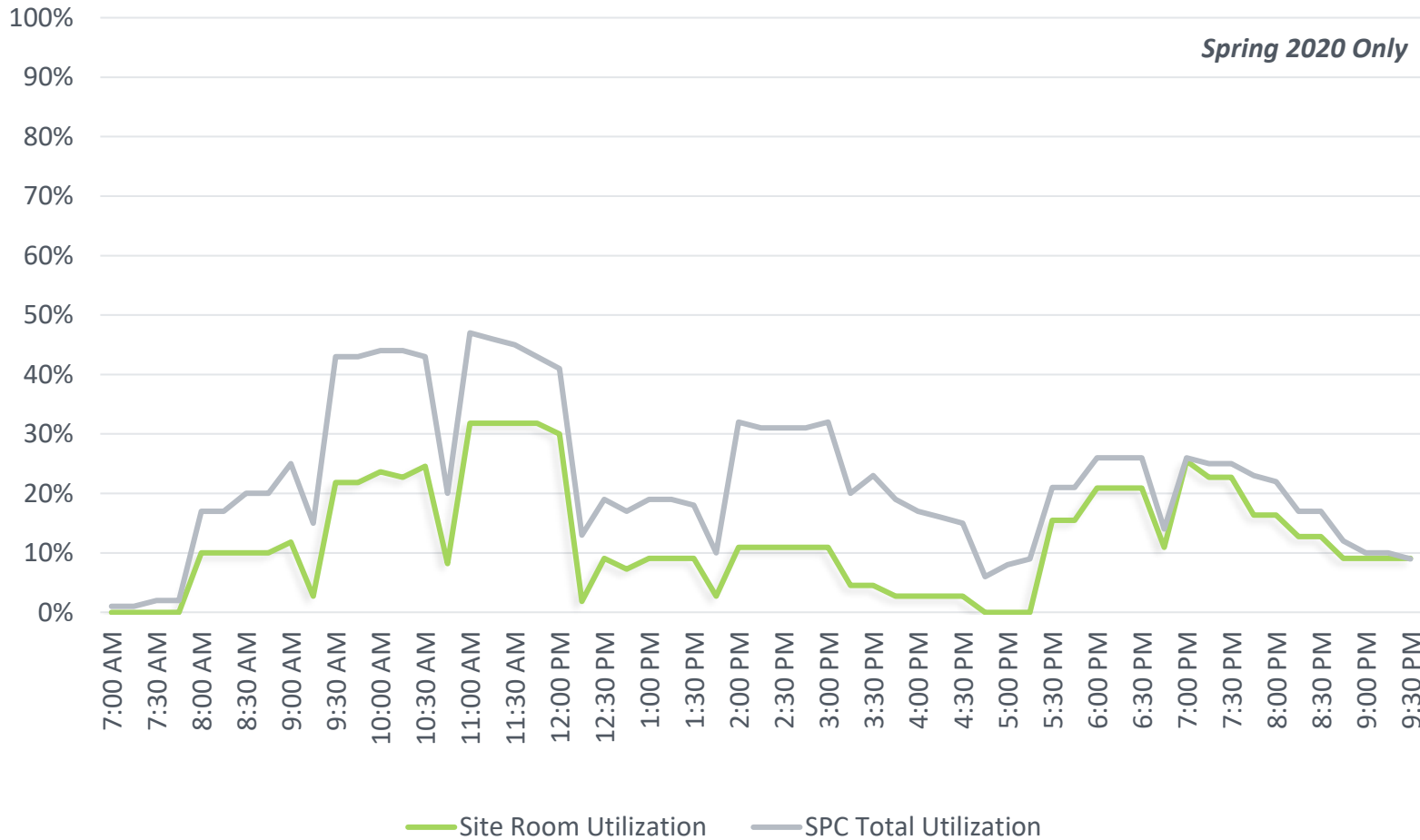

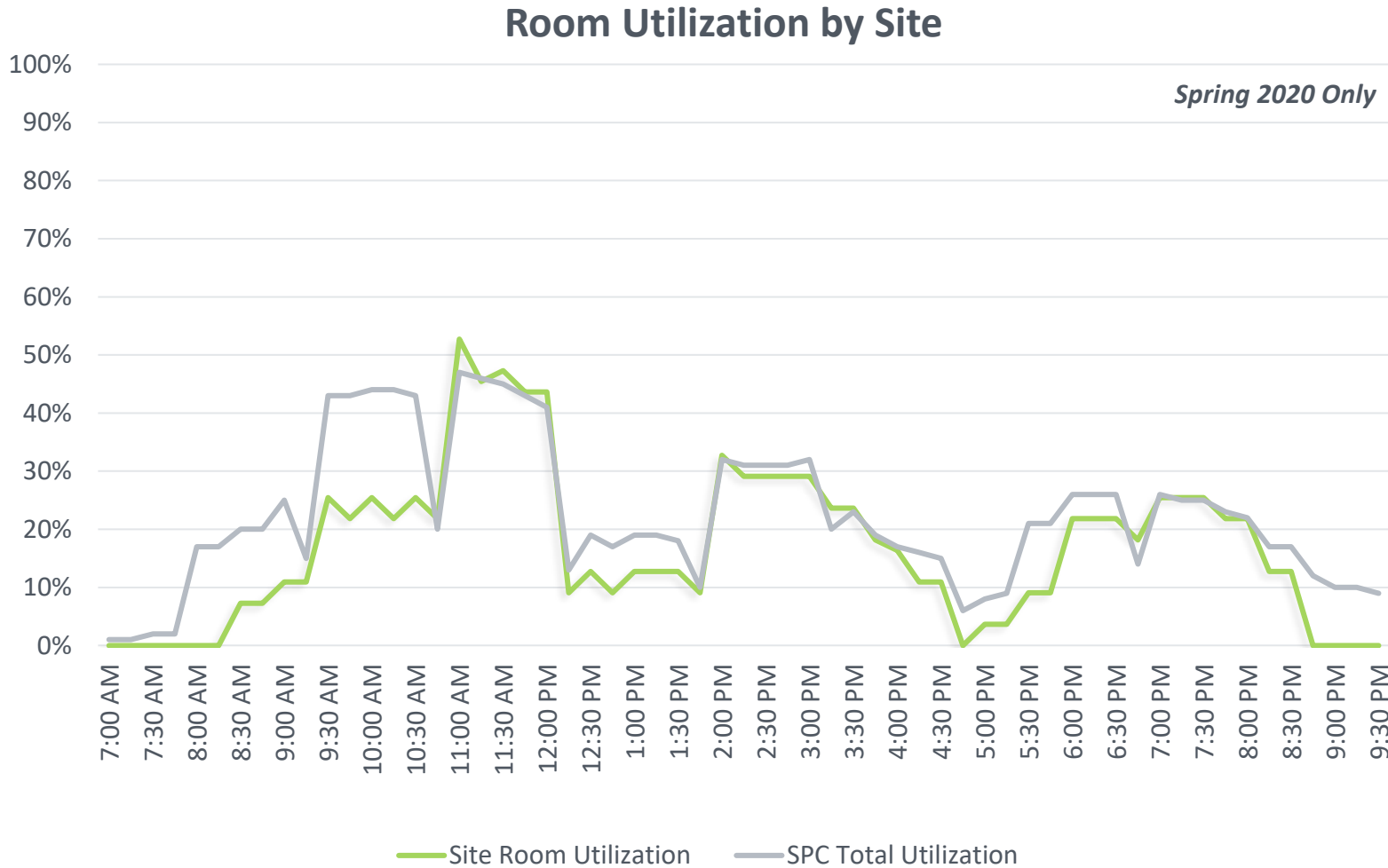

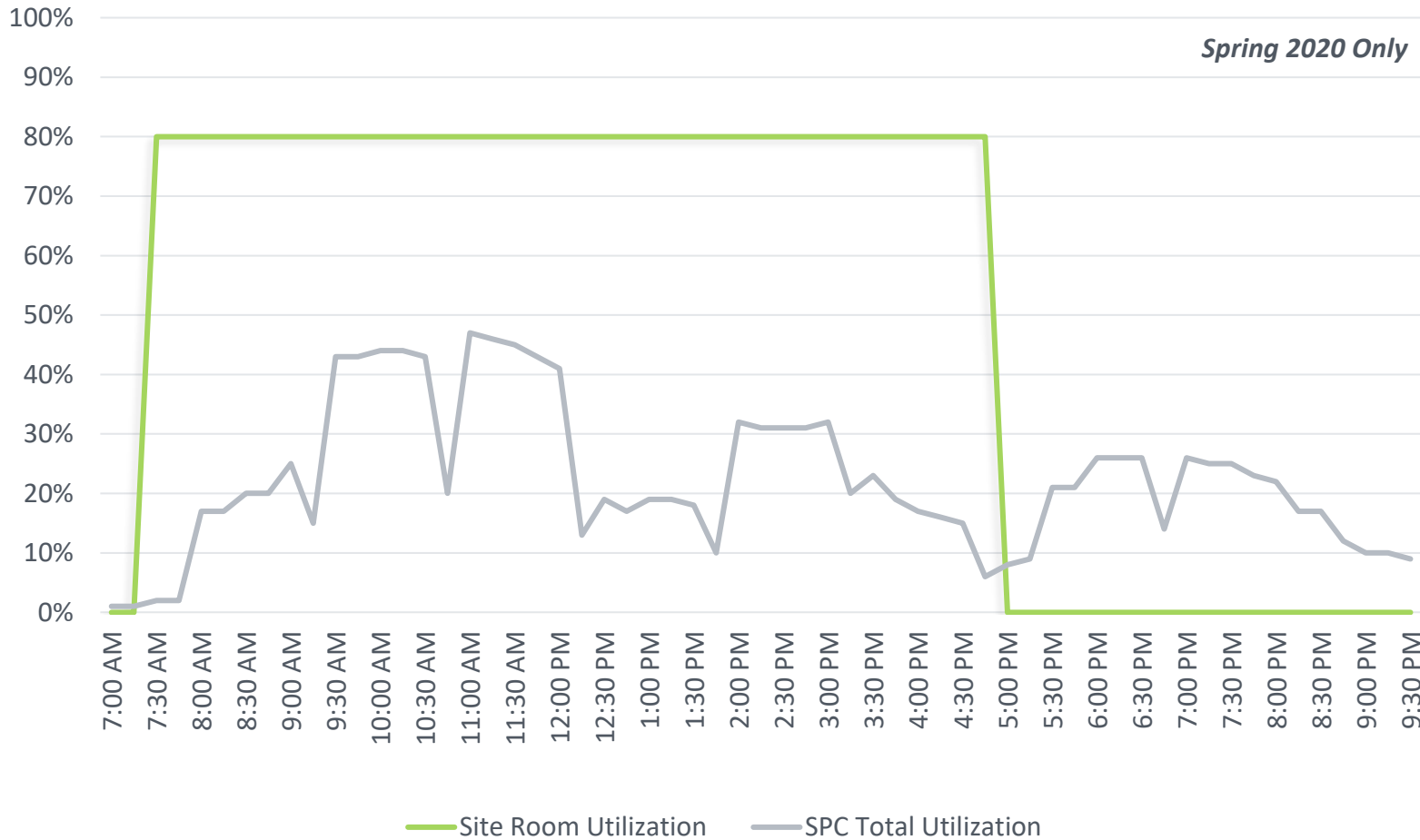

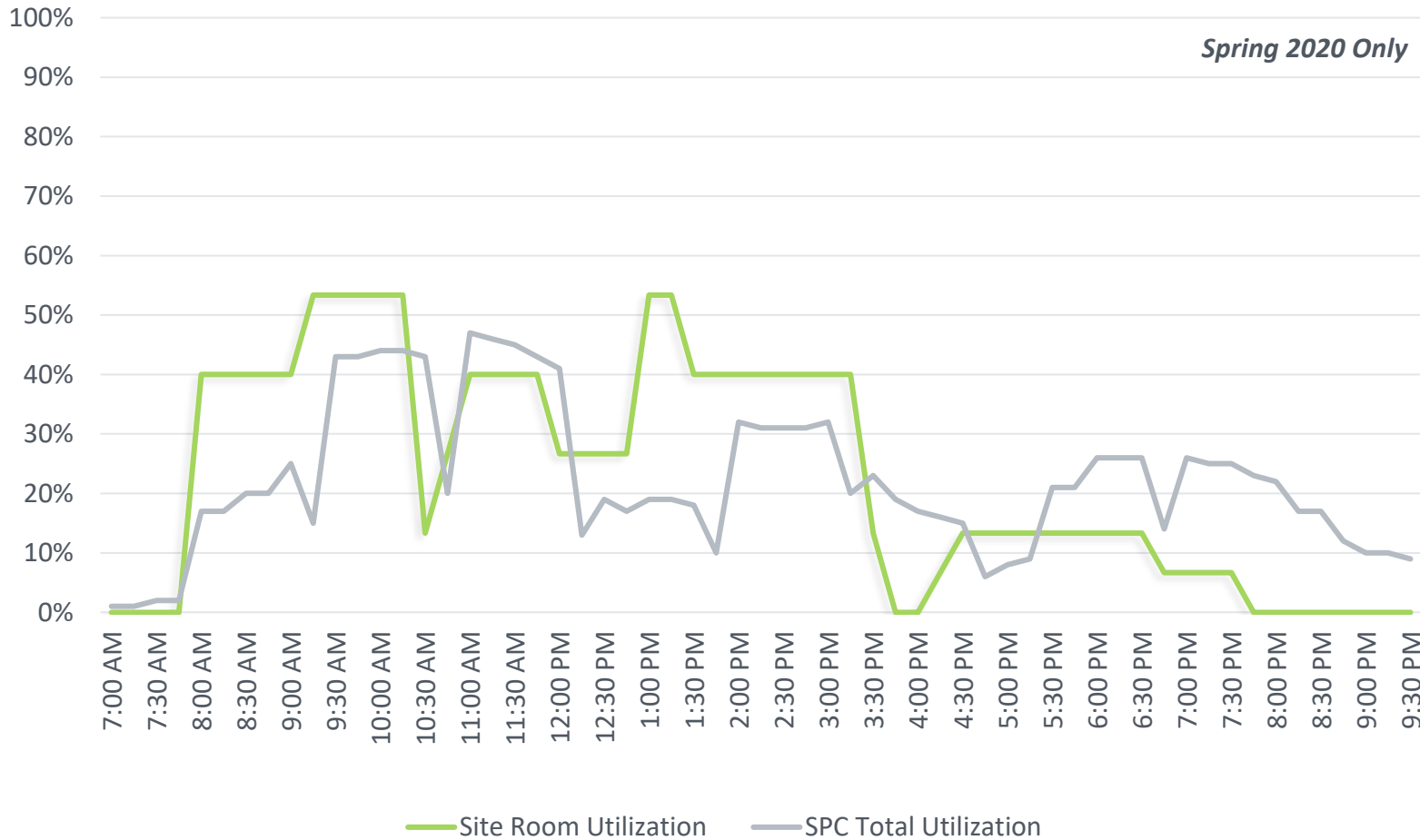
