The mission of the **Brother to Brother** program is to provide a highly focused and integrated model of academic, social, career and co-curricular resources that aim to increase the retention, progression and graduation rates of young men at SPC. This program provides a wraparound system of support through various resources, mentoring and forms of engagement that encourage academic achievement, and promote personal and professional development.

PROGRAM VISION

Brother to Brother seeks to supply intentional and direct resources to male students that are intended to provide additional layers of academic, professional and social support. We aspire to set the standard for male students at SPC recognized for academic achievement, co-curricular involvement and a commitment to service.



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St. Petersburg College's Brother to Brother program welcomes its partnership with the [Community Foundation Tampa Bay](#) and [Helios Education Foundation](#) to offer additional services in support of the **Florida African American Male Experience (FAAME)**. The initiative aims to empower African American male students in their journey to postsecondary degree completion.

These services include but are not limited to:

- Intensive wraparound, out-of-class services for the FAAME cohort including one-on-one tutoring, mentorship and academic advising support
- Increased financial support with the goal of our male students graduating with a four-year baccalaureate degree and zero or reduced student loan debt
- A fast-tracked pathway that removes barriers to success for students as they graduate from high school and work toward earning their bachelor's degree

FAAME is an expansion of the Helios-SPC Titan Achievement Program (H-TAP) grant, awarded to SPC in 2020 to assess the educational pathways of African American males in Pinellas County.

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
