Emphasis is placed on learning creative processes, technical training, business practices and entrepreneurial skills. Everything is taught in a collaborative, hands-on environment.

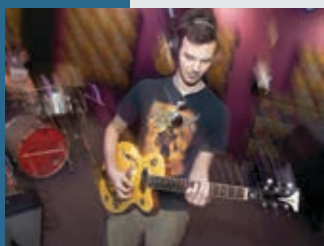

IMMERSIVE LEARNING, HIGH-TECH FACILITIES



The MIRA program has fully loaded, multi-faceted audio production suites geared toward the aspiring music professional.

STUDIO A: MIRA

This studio is used primarily for music recording and has the capability to record medium-size ensembles.



STUDIO B: THE ANNEX

This studio is used primarily for music mixing, audio for video post-production, and overdubbing.

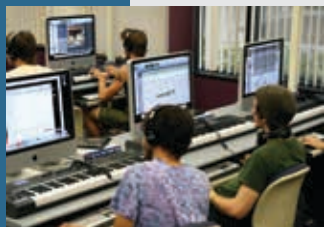
STUDIO C: BROADCAST CENTER

DEDICATED REHEARSAL SPACES

MIRA has two large dedicated rehearsal spaces for ensembles to prepare for concerts and learn new material. These spaces have drums, backline and PA setups.



PRODUCTION LABS

Our three production labs include over 50 digital audio workstations on Apple computers equipped with Pro Tools, Ableton, Reason, Native Instruments, Waves and other industry-standard production software, as well as production hardware.

PLANS



PAINTING

Painting is one of the most traditional of the Fine Arts and covers a variety of media. The art department at St. Petersburg College offers courses in technique, contemporary art, theory and criticism.



PRINTMAKING

Printmaking at St. Petersburg College introduces you to the basic nature of the medium, both in a historical and conceptual context. Mediums such as relief printing, monoprints, intaglio, and screen printing are covered. Students will work on developing imagery and concepts within the specific medium to create a body of work.



DRAWING

Our drawing classes have been carefully designed to provide students with the training needed to turn abstract ideas into reality. By teaching the skills necessary to complete proficient representational drawings, our faculty will help you improve your mastery of techniques, such as line, shape, perspective and development of value for light, form and space.



CERAMICS

Ceramics classes at St. Petersburg College introduce design techniques and the history of ceramics. Experienced professors teach you the techniques to design, build and fire ceramic objects. Our ceramics studio is well-equipped with a variety of electric and gas-fired kilns, pottery wheels and equipment.



DESIGN

St. Petersburg College's Fine Arts department offers many foundational courses designed to develop your knowledge and perception of two- and three-dimensional form and its elements. These courses provide an introduction to basic design concepts, skills and processes.



DANCE

St. Petersburg College's classes and workshops in jazz, ballet and modern dance prepare you to perform and help you connect with professional dancers and choreographers.

An Associate in Arts degree with a dance emphasis prepares you to continue your education or work professionally in the field of dance performance, instruction or choreography.

OPERA WORKSHOPS

SUMMER VOCAL INSTITUTE

CULTURAL VENUES



LEEPA-RATTNER MUSEUM OF ART

The Leepa-Rattner Museum of Art is a modern and contemporary art museum featuring more than 6,000 works of 20th and 21st century art. Located on the Tarpon Springs Campus, the museum's collection centers around the work of Allen Leepa, Esther Gentle and Abraham Rattner.

Our students experience art and music first-hand at SPC's amazing cultural venues.

MUSIC CENTER

This state-of-the-art, acoustically perfect performing hall is equipped with two Steinway concert grand pianos and a breathtaking Heissler tracker pipe organ made of solid oak. Located on the St. Petersburg/Gibbs Campus, the Music Center seats an audience of more than 300 and regularly features student performances as well as renowned artists from around the world.

THE PALLADIUM THEATER AT SPC

This community theater in downtown St. Petersburg began in 1998 and became part of St. Petersburg College in early 2007.

The Palladium Theater has two venues, the 850-seat main concert area, Hough Hall, and its intimate, award-winning, 175-seat candlelit listening room, The Side Door. The theater fosters artistically and culturally diverse performing arts, plus educational and film programs that bring artists and audiences together in a first-class professional, affordable setting. Students from our music programs and sound technology classes are given a myriad of opportunities to work intimately with touring professionals and local artists.

THE CROSSROADS GALLERY

The Crossroads Gallery, located at the Clearwater Campus, is a 1,000-square-foot gallery space featuring regular exhibitions of student work, along with the work of visiting artists. The opportunity for exhibiting their work gives students real-world experience in installing and lighting their art in a gallery setting.
