



SPC is an Open Access Institution

- ➤ Will I Be Accepted? YES!
- ➤ High school diploma, GED transcript, or home school affidavit.
- Admissions is NOT based on test scores (ACT, SAT, or PERT)
 - Instead, scores determine what course you start with.

Step 2: Submit Transcripts

- OFFICIAL transcripts
- <u>Directly from your institution</u> to SPC
- Or, in an unopened envelope from your school

How to Submit:

- Electronically FASTEST!

- Post to Office of Admissions and Records, SPC, PO Box 33089, St Petersburg, FL 33733.

What to Submit:	Already Have a Degree?
Proof of High School graduation	You <u>do not</u> need to submit high school transcript
+ Transcripts from any College / University attended	+ Transcripts from any College / University attended

Will My Credits Transfer?

St. Petersburg College is accredited by the

Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACS-COC).

- * SPC is regionally accredited.
- * Credits from other regionally accredited Colleges or Universities will transfer to SPC.
- * Apply first, then submit your official transcript to know if your credits will transfer.




Step 3: College Placement Test

- *Determines what course level to start with.
- *SAT, ACT, or PERT scores under 2 years can count.

What if I don't have test scores?

- College Placement Test is FREE for SPC students (first attempt).
- Not all classes require testing, however all degree programs do.
- Florida high school students who graduated after 2007 may OPT out of testing.
- Students with college-level classes from another institution may be exempt.
