Provost, St. Petersburg College 2015-Present

Seminole Campus: Provides campus leadership and is accountable for all campus operations, including efforts to ensure that the full range of support programs and services are optimal in assisting all students succeed in their academic goals. Health Education (HEC) and Vet Tech Centers (VT): In addition to serving Seminole Campus, also serves as campus administrative lead for health education and veterinary training at two additional sites. Thus, the job description is nearly identical to the provost role at Seminole Campus and all other campuses. However, academic programs at HEC and VT are very much different in the students it serves, along with the academic pathways. Nursing, and Allied Health are mission critical in relation to the students that graduate and matriculate to jobs in and around the Tampa Bay area.

Associate Provost St. Petersburg College, St. Petersburg, FL 2011-2015

Associate Provost, Downtown Campus: Served as campus leader in Provost's absence and assist the Provost in building and supporting an effective leadership team. Provided leadership along with the Provost for essential aspects of campus operations including: overseeing student support services and programs, management of student appeals, and work with campus and district personnel for continued process improvements in Career and Academic Advising, Admissions, Registration, and Student Affairs. Participated in strategic planning, development, and management of budgets for my areas of supervision. Worked collaboratively alongside the Provost with faculty, staff, and students on college and campus goals and initiatives in support of student learning and academic success. Lastly, served as appointed campus representative for campus wide complaints and concerns.

Director, Athletics St. Petersburg College, St. Petersburg, FL 2007-2015

Director, Athletics: Directed and managed intercollegiate athletic department with 25 full and part-time employees. Directly responsible for 2-million-dollar budget, scheduling of all home and away contests, approval of scholarships to student athletes, eligibility, and compliance. During my time as Athletic Director, I rewrote the rules and procedures manual for athletics, along with reorganized and reallocated funds to adequately be distributed among the six sports, which allowed the college to comply with Title IX. In addition to my duties as AD, I was the chair of the Suncoast Conference, and I was the statewide chair for tennis. Lastly, I was elected as the Council of Athletic Affairs chair elect, which is for the governing body for junior college athletics in Florida. However, I was unable to serve in this role as I was promoted to Provost and subsequently resigned as Athletic Director.

Director, Enrollment Management St. Petersburg College, St. Petersburg, FL 2003-2011

Director, Enrollment Management: Planned, directed, advised current and prospective students, and implemented management of enrollment management efforts related to recruitment and computerized tracking of prospective students, and coordinated recruitment with intake processes, academic offerings and course scheduling. Lastly, concerning Enrollment Management, I trained, directed, and evaluated all personnel under immediate supervision. Position was formally Coordinator, and I was promoted to Director in fall of 2005. In addition to my role as Director of Enrollment Management, during 2011, prior to being promoted as Associate Provost, I briefly assumed additional duties where I oversaw the College-wide Volunteer Program. The volunteer program coordinated volunteers for college-wide initiatives, collaborates with student life and leadership coordinators and college recruiters to facilitate a student ambassador program, works closely with the Student Government Association members and other student leadership organizations to provide volunteer opportunities in the college and the community.
