WHAT IS ROTC and HOW to JOIN

- Commissioning source for the Army, 70% of all Army Officers completed ROTC
- Graduates will serve either on Active Duty (4yr) or National Guard/Reserves for (6yr)
- Scholarships are available: 4yr, 3.5yr, 3yr, 2.5yr and 2yr scholarships
- Must be a "Full-Time" college student to participate in ROTC (12 credits sem)
- Must be a US citizen either born or naturalized. Non US citizens can participate in Fresh/Soph
- Must be of good moral character without criminal background*
- Must be medically cleared for military service (DODMERB)

NATIONAL CADET COMMAND SCHOLARSHIP

- 2022 National Profile: 4yr winner SAT 1320 GPA 3.77, 3yr winner SAT 1250, GPA 3.59
- SAT/ACT
- GPA of 3.5 or higher (unweighted)
- National Honors Society (leader*)
- Student Government
- Any school sponsored clubs (leader*)
- 2 or more Varsity Letters (leader*)
- JROTC participation (leader positions and teams*)
- Individual athletic events; club/rec league sports, 3-5-10K races
- Eagle Scout, Boy/Girl State
- 200 volunteer hours
- Complete the Physical Assessment test (1 min push-ups, 1 min sit-ups, 1 mile run)
- Job (not required)

SCHOLARSHIP FROM SUNCOAST BATTALION

- Full time college student enrolled in ROTC
- Be medically qualified (DODMERB)
- Pass Army Physical Fitness Test (1min push-up, 1min sit-up 1 mile run)
- Established college GPA(2.5 min)
- Be endorsed by PMS/Cadre (ROTC is privilege not a right)
- National Board Applicants NOT selected, 3yr Advanced Designee *******

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

- Either Tuition or Room and Board; R&B is a flat fee of 10K (5K per semester)
- All options include \$1,200 (\$600 per semester) books, Stipend of \$420 per month
- USF, SPC, HCC have different rates for in-state/out of state tuition
- Saint Leo, Eckerd (private schools) have same rate for In-state/out of state
- Saint Leo gives FREE Room & Board to all scholarshipped cadets
