#### Accreditation

#### Academic Calendar

The academic year includes four quarters, and students may enroll each quarter, including the optional summer quarter.

### Quarter Hour

Each quarter credit hour requires 10 hours of instruction, and an additional 20 hours of outof-class time by students. SCAD sometimes offers courses in a compressed time frame of less than a 10-week quarter; however, in all cases the standard for earning a quarter credit (10 contact hours, plus 20 additional out-of-class hours) is maintained.

# Grade Point Average

#### Additional Grade Codes

# Auditing (N)

Currently enrolled degree-seeking, non-degree seeking or transient students who wish to enroll in a course, but do not want to receive a grade, may request through the registrar to audit the course, provided space is available and they are eligible to register for the course they wish to audit. # Exemption from Course (EX)

A student who is exempted from a required course does not earn academic credit for the exempted course and must fulfill the number of hours required to complete the degree through a course substitution from the same subject area as approved by the department chair.

Prior to fall 2010, graduate students entering directly into the Professional Master of Architecture program were allowed up to 180 hours of granted course credit dependent upon previous degree(s) earned.

# No Grade (NG)

No grade submitted by faculty at this time.

# Satisfactory (S)

A grade of "Satisfactory" denotes successful completion of course requirements. This code is used only for non-credit bearing courses.

# Unsatisfactory (U)

A grade of "Unsatisfactory" denotes unsuccessful completion of course requirements. This code is used for non-credit bearing courses.

# Temporary Grade of Incomplete (I)

A student who has suffered serious personal illness or other emergency circumstances during the academic term and is therefore unable to complete all assignments by the end of the quarter may request a grade of incomplete through the appropriate school dean. A student, who is assigned a temporary grade of incomplete, is required to complete the

remainder of the unfinished coursework in a satisfactory manner by midterm of the following quarter or the grade automatically changes to an F. To view the SCAD incomplete policy in its entirety, refer to scad.edu/temporary-grade-incomplete.

### Withdrawal (W)

After the end of the drop/add period and through the last day of the quarter, students may officially withdraw from a course. To view the SCAD withdrawal policy in its entirety, refer to scad.edu/withdrawal.
