HELPING FIRST GENERATION AND LIMITED INCOME STUDENTS GRADUATE FROM COLLEGE

Student Support Services (SSS) provides year-round mentoring and support for college students and is designed to significantly increase the retention and graduation rates of its participants. Students must apply and be accepted into this limited-access program. This program provides:

- Academic advising
- Academic progress reports
- Career exploration activities
- Counseling
- Referral to additional campus and community resources
- Textbook/Laptop lending library
- Tutoring
- Transfer assistance and university tours
- Workshops

Who can apply to Student Support Services?

To be eligible, SPC students must be U.S. citizens (or permanent residents), be degree seeking and meet at least one of the following criteria:

1. Be a first-generation college student (neither parent having earned a bachelor's degree), and/or
2. Be low-income based on the U.S. Department of Education guidelines
