Help registering for classes, access to or information about outside resources, help planning or choosing courses, or career guidance	<u>Advising</u>
Help with finding SPC and community resources related to student mental health, food insecurity, transportation, or other non-academic issues	<u>Resources for Life Issues</u>
Assistance with finding, organizing, or citing sources; tutoring and study strategies; MyCourses help; computer and printer access to complete assignments; quiet study space	<u>Learning Resources</u>
Help with technical issues related to MySPC, MyCourses, student email and other technology-related concerns	<u>Technical Support Center</u>
Information about individual accommodations or classroom modifications, such as notetaking or adaptive technology	<u>Accessibility Services</u>
Scheduling makeup testing when approved by faculty, testing accommodations with approval from accessibility services, and placement testing	<u>Testing Center</u>
Guidance and assistance in finding federal aid to pay for tuition and course textbooks and materials	<u>Financial Aid</u>
Opportunities to interact with peers outside of the classroom, pathways to leadership	<u>Student Life & Leadership</u>
Help deciding on a major or future occupation, training in employability skills (such as resume writing or interview skills), help developing a professional network, access to information about jobs and internships	<u>Career Services</u>
Mentoring and guidance for men, access to resources	<u>MAX – Men Achieving Excellence</u>
Mentoring and guidance for women, access to resources	<u>WOW – Women on the Way</u>
